

## **Initial Teacher Licensure – Job-Embedded Clinical Practice Program Entry Requirements**

Candidates applying for the job-embedded path to a practitioner license must meet the following requirements:

**I. Candidate must hold a bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited college or university.**

**II. Candidate must demonstrate knowledge of the content area by:**

**For PreK-12, K-12, PreK-3, or K-5 endorsements (e.g., ESL, PE, early childhood, elementary):**

- submission of passing scores on the Praxis <https://praxis.ets.org/state-requirements/tennessee-tests.html> content knowledge assessment(s) aligned to the qualifying K-12 endorsement.

**For 6-8 or 6-12 endorsements (e.g., middle grades science, biology, math, Spanish):**

- Having a qualifying degree with a content major aligned to the endorsement area (verified by Office of Educator Preparation and Licensure via official transcript).

**OR**

- Submission of passing scores on the content knowledge assessment(s) aligned to the endorsement area.

  - National Evaluation Series (NES) is also accepted for **Mathematics ONLY** <https://home.pearsonvue.com/nas>

Due to frequent changes to professional assessments required for teacher licensure, please refer to the **State Board of Education Professional Assessments for Tennessee Educators 5.105 policy** <https://www.tn.gov/sbe/rules--policies-and-guidance/policies.html> for specific requirements.

**III. Complete the [Job-Embedded Eligibility Form](#)**

The following documentation must be submitted when applying.

- **Letter of Intent to Hire from a school district** – An official letter from the school district stating the candidate's position, subject, grade level, endorsement code, and the name of the school where they will be teaching.

- **Official Transcripts:** Candidates must submit **official** transcripts that show degree conferment. Electronic transcripts must be sent directly from the institution to MTSU or [patti.agnew@mtsu.edu](mailto:patti.agnew@mtsu.edu). Paper transcripts must be sealed. International transcripts must first be evaluated by a member of the National Association of Credential Evaluation Services (NACES)

- **Assessment Score Report:** If a content assessment is required, the candidate must upload a copy of a score report reflecting attainment of the currently required qualifying score.

##### Graduate

- If seeking a master's degree with licensure, apply through Graduate Studies as a graduate student seeking a master's degree in the appropriate initial licensure area:
  - Elementary Education – Master of Arts in Teaching
  - ESL – Master of Arts in Teaching
  - Library Media Specialist – Master of Library Science
  - Secondary Education – Master of Arts in Teaching
- If seeking licensure only, apply through Graduate Studies as a non-degree seeking student in the Job-Embedded Program.

##### Undergraduate

- If your licensure program of study only includes undergraduate coursework, you can enroll as an undergraduate post-baccalaureate student.

- **GPA:** A minimum overall GPA of 2.75 from a completed baccalaureate or post-baccalaureate degree program or a GPA of 3.00 in the most recent sixty (60) credit hours earned at a regionally accredited institution of higher learning.
- **Test Score:** If required, acceptable score(s) on appropriate content knowledge assessment(s) for the subject the candidate is applying to teach. Upload to the online application.
